**Under this agreement for 2017  
Taranganba State School will receive**

**\$255 482 \***

## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students in all year levels achieving an A or B standard in English to 45% in both semesters
- To be at National Mean Scale Score in Reading, Writing and Spelling in both Years 3 and 5 2017 NAPLAN results
- To have 96% of all students in Years 3 & 5 above the National Minimum Standard (NMS) for Reading, Writing and Spelling in 2017 NAPLAN results.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving in the top two bands of NAPLAN 5 reading from 30.4% in 2016 to 40% in 2017 and NAPLAN Year 5 Writing from 17.2% in 2016 to 25% in 2017.

## Our initiatives include

- Provision of High Reliability Literacy Strategies for the teaching of all reading – guided and whole class through a school wide pedagogical approach based on the work of Dr John Munro.
- Continue the provision of highly trained teacher aides for guided reading lessons across the school from Prep to Year 6.
- Continue the professional development and collegial observations and feedback cycles to all teachers and teacher aides, enhancing pedagogy and subject knowledge. Engage in professional learning teams, funding release time for collaborative planning, assessment tasks and moderation.
- Provide additional resources to support the reading and writing programs to support implementation.
- Continue to develop and align the school writing program with the Taranganba Way of Reading pedagogy and scope and sequence.

Employment of additional teacher aides to support the delivery of the guided reading program	\$ 200 000
Purchasing additional teacher release time for the provision of collaborative planning, observation and feedback cycles.	\$ 40 000
Purchasing resources to support program implementation	\$ 15 482
