This funding will be used to

- 85% students achieving a C or above in English, Mathematics, Science in Prep to Year 2
- 90% students achieving a C or above in English, Mathematics and Science in Year 3 - 6
- 50% students achieving an A or B in English, Mathematics and Science in Year 1 – 2
- 60% students achieving an A or B in English, Mathematics and Science in Year 3 – 6
- 85% Indigenous students achieving A - C in English and Mathematics to meet Regional Performance Measures

Our initiatives include

- Speech Language Pathologist collecting and reviewing data, collaboratively developing oral language, phonics and phonemic awareness programs to meet the needs of all students from Prep to Year 3 embedded in the Early Identification and Intervention Inquiry Cycle
- Occupational Therapist engaged one day per week supporting and developing teacher capability with a key focus on fine and gross motor development for Prep and Year 1 children
- Embed a multi-tiered system of support and intervention through Engagement Hubs including teacher and teacher aides to ensure that learning environments and teaching approaches support full participation and access for all children
- Developing and building capability to support educational adjustments through a team approach to inclusive practices to maximise student learning outcomes for every student, every day
- Engagement teachers and Speech Pathologist delivering MacqLit reading program for identified children in Year 5 for intensive support and intervention

Permanent employment of a Speech Pathologist (3 days per week)	\$ 50 157
Purchase of an Occupational Therapist (1 day per week)	\$ 20 389
Purchasing additional teaching fractions to supplement teaching teams	\$263 892
