## This funding will be used to

- Monitor and demonstrate continuous improvement in Levels of Achievement (LOA) in English,
   Mathematics and Science for all students across Prep to Year 6
- Document differentiated, supplementary, substantial and extensive adjustments through personalised learning plans for students and identified in NCCD collection of evidence
- Embed Structured Literacy blocks across the school from Prep to Year 6

#### Our initiatives include

- Speech Language Pathologist collecting and reviewing data, collaboratively developing oral language, phonics and phonemic awareness programs to meet the needs of all students from Prep to Year 3 to embed a multi-tiered system of support
- Occupational Therapist engaged one day per week supporting and developing teacher capability with a key focus on developing a multi-tiered system of support
- Develop and build capability of teachers and teacher aides to support educational adjustments through a multi-tiered system of support and intervention
- Refine our multi-tiered system of support and intervention through Engagement Hubs, to ensure that learning environments and teaching approaches support full participation and access for all children
- Developing and building capability to support educational adjustments through a team approach
  to inclusive practices to maximise student learning outcomes for every student, every day
- Implement Structured Literacy Blocks across the school throughout 2022

### Our school will improve student outcomes by

Permanent employment of a Speech Pathologist (3 days per week) \$ 70 000
 Purchase of an Occupational Therapist (1 day per week) \$ 24 000
 Purchasing additional teaching fractions to supplement teaching teams \$ 246 279
