## This funding will be used to

- 85% students achieving a C or above in English, Mathematics, Science in Prep to Year 2
- 90% students achieving a C or above in English, Mathematics and Science in Year 3 - 6
- 50% students achieving an A or B in English, Mathematics and Science in Year 1 – 2
- 60% students achieving an A or B in English, Mathematics and Science in Year 3 – 6
- 85% indigenous students achieving A - C in English and Mathematics to meet Regional Performance Measures

## Our initiatives include

- Speech Language Pathologist collecting and reviewing data, collaboratively developing oral language programs to meet the needs of all students
- Extending Letters and Sounds program to Year 2 with teachers working together collaboratively with Speech Language Pathologist and leadership team through the Early Identification and Intervention inquiry cycle
- Focusing on rigorous understanding of school curriculum plan to build teacher capability and implementation of Australian Curriculum with fidelity and integrity
- Implementing collaborative planning and moderation processes through implementation of Curriculum Assessment and Reporting Action Plan
- Developing and building capability to support educational adjustments through a team approach to inclusive practices to maximise student learning outcomes for every student, every day

Employment of a Speech Pathologist (3 days per week)	\$56 599
Providing collaborative planning and moderation through teacher release	\$40 425
Purchasing additional 0.5 FTE teaching fraction to release Head of Department (Curriculum) from teaching load	\$41 652
Purchasing additional teaching fractions to supplement teaching teams with inclusion and disability support staff	\$178 509
